October 30, 2026 (Friday)	Nomination Forms, Intent to Run letters, Biographies and Photos are due to PGCEA by 5:00 pm. Nomination Forms must: • Be submitted via JotForm. • Include all required answers. • Include an Intent to Run letter.

	• Include photos and bios for all PGCEA President, Vice-President, and Board of Director Candidates. • Photos and bios must be submitted at the time the nomination form is completed. Late submissions will not be accepted. See Fair Campaign Code for publication requirements.
October 30, 2026 (Friday)	NECC meets to validate nomination forms, bios, and flyers. NECC will notify candidates via email of eligibility.
November 23, 2026 (Monday)	NECC will announce candidate names running for PGCEA President, Vice-President and Board of Directors. Candidates may now begin campaigning.
December 14, 2026	Candidate Speeches: Three (3) min to speak at Rep Council. Speeches will be posted on the website within 5 business days.
By December 18, 2026 (Friday)	Last day to withdraw Candidacy
January 8, 2027 (Friday)	The final slate of candidates will be announced by NECC on the PGCEA Website. All Candidate bios and photos will be posted on the PGCEA Website.
January 15, 2027 (Friday)	Membership applications must be in PGCEA office by cut-off date for new members to be eligible to vote.
January 2027 (TBA)	The NECC will review and test e-ballot.
January 15, 2027 (Friday)	Last day to request worksite labels. Last day to have flyers placed in the PGCPs Pony by PGCEA. Please Note: Labels will cost \$30.00
